- The entire Animal Shelter enjoys a complete air filtration system which provides air exchanges every fifteen minutes of every day.
- All dogs have access to large outdoor runs to maintain healthy muscle tone.
- Quarantine cages segregate sick animals from the general population. An inhouse infirmary, not open to the public, provides treatment for ailing Shelter residents.
- Cats brought to the Shelter are housed in a soundproof area. This stress-free environment consists of twenty-four cages complete with skylight above.
- All pets, where appropriate, receive inoculations and are spayed/neutered upon adoption.

A Special Way to Protect Your Pet 🔀



The Town of Oyster Bay Animal Shelter is equipped with a universal scanner. This device enables Shelter personnel to identify lost pets whose owners have had them implanted with a special microchip.

The microchip is encoded with data about the animal and is painlessly implanted by a private veterinarian.

If a microchip-protected pet becomes lost and is recovered by the Shelter, information about the animal and its owner's identity can be obtained by waving the scanner over the pet.
